

# EVENT SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

— PART ONE —



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## 1. JURISDICTION

The **Barry Robinson Memorial Rally Southland** is a National Rally, promoted by the **Eastern Southland Car Club Inc** and will take place on the **18<sup>th</sup> July 2026** in the **Wyndham, Mataura and Dunsdale areas**.

This Rally is the third Round of the 2026 Brian Green Property Group New Zealand Rally Championship (NZRC), fourth Round of the 2026 Mainland Rally Championship and 2026 Fern H6 Cup Series, and in addition, ESCC members will score points for the ESCC Rally Champion trophy.

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code (hereafter referred to as "National Sporting Code") and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix 3, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies, and Appendix 2, Schedule A – Driver Safety and Vehicle Requirements.

The MotorSport New Zealand Permit Number is 260247.

### 3. THE EVENT

- 3.1** The Barry Robinson Memorial Rally Southland will begin on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July with Documentation, and the competition will begin on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> July.
- 3.2 Venue:** the Eastern Southland District, Southland.
- 3.3 Length:** comprises approximately 160km of Special Stages and 180km of Touring.
- 3.4 First Car Starts:** Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2026 at 8:30am from Redan Street, Wyndham in front of the MLT Three Rivers Hotel.
- 3.5 First Car Finishes:** Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2026 at approx. 3:45pm at the final Time Control which is situated at the ILT Ascot Hotel, corner of Tay Street and Racecourse Road, Invercargill.

### 4. THE EVENT

- 4.1 Opening and Closing:** entries open with the publication of these Supplementary Regulations Part One. Normal entries close at 5:00pm on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2026. Entries made online or emailed after the normal closing date may be subject to the late fee.
- 4.2 Entry Acceptance:** entries shall be made on MotorSport Online or using the correct entry form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all detail and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the Organising Committee's discretion. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.
- 4.3 Entry Fee (per competing vehicle):** The Entry Fees below include RallySafe, two Dinner Tickets per competing vehicle, and GST (all entry fees exclude Safety Notes and the Reconnaissance Fee)

There is no additional charge for Service Crew registration.

- 4.4 Number of Starters:** The Organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 60 entries are received at the normal closing date. The maximum number of starters will be 90. Any additional entries will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.
- 4.5 Acceptance of Entry:** Supplementary Regulations Part Two will be emailed by Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2026 together with a seeded Start List.
- 4.6 Competitor Requirements:**
- a. Knowledge and Understandings:** In signing the entry form, all Entrants, Drivers, and Co-Drivers are deemed to fully understand the current MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules, particularly the Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and Appendix Three Schedule R Articles pertaining to Stage Notes, Pace Notes and Reconnaissance.
  - b. Licence Requirements:** Both the Driver and Co-Driver must hold a National Rally (R1 or R2) Grade Licence or higher MotorSport New Zealand issued Competition Licence. Applicable Motorsport Australia Competition Licences are acceptable as per National Sporting Code, Appendix 1, Schedule L – Licences, Article 5.2.  
If the Entrant is not the Driver, that Entrant must hold a current Entrants Licence.



- c. **New Competitors:** All Drivers and Co-Drivers who have not previously competed in three or more rallies must attend a New Competitors Briefing. The time (Friday evening) and venue for this briefing will be announced in Supplementary Regulations Part Two.
- d. **Rejoining:** The Road Book contains a "Temporary Withdrawal" form, a "Final Withdrawal" form, and a "Rejoining" form.

No crew will be permitted to restart the rally once they have handed in a "Final Withdrawal" form.

If a crew believes that they may be able to restart the rally after an incident or mechanical breakdown they must complete a "Temporary Withdrawal" form and hand it to an event Official as soon as practicable.

If a crew then wishes to re-join the rally they must do so at a Start Control of a Special Stage at a point which will not cause any delay to the event. They must hand in a "Rejoining" form to the Special Stage Control Officer. All cars that have suffered accident damage must be checked and cleared by the Chief Scrutineer or their appointed assistant **before** rejoining.

Points at which a competitor may rejoin the rally will be advised in Supplementary Regulations Part Two.

## 5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

- 5.1 **Compliance:** All cars must comply with National Sporting Code, Appendix Two, Schedule A, and Appendix Three, Schedule R unless stated otherwise in the Event Supplementary Regulations.

- 5.2 **Classes:** Cars will be divided into the following classes. The Organisers reserve the right to combine classes if there are less than five entries in a class at the normal close of entries.

You can only enter one class in each category.

Category 1; 2; 3; 4; 5; or 6

### **Mainland Rally Championship** (in conjunction with the Mainland Championship Rules)

Class A: 2WD 1-1300cc;

Class B: 2WD 1301-1600cc;

Class C: 2WD 1601 and over;

Class D: 4WD;

Class E: Pre 1996 Classic 4WD;

Class F: 0-1700cc Classic; 2WD;

Class G: 1701cc and over Classic 2WD; or

Class H: Subaru H6

## 6. DOCUMENTATION AND AUDIT SCRUTINEERING

- 6.1 **Documentation:** Competitors must present themselves at Documentation for the checking of their Civil Drivers Licence, Competition Licence, Car Club Membership, and Logbook, and issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material.

Documentation will be held at the ILT Ascot Park Hotel, corner of Tay Street and Racecourse Road, Invercargill from 3:30pm until 5:30pm on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2026.

A second period of Documentation for those not doing Reconnaissance will be held at the ILT Ascot Park Hotel, corner of Tay Street and Racecourse Road, Invercargill from 12:30pm to 1:30pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2026.

If you are unable to attend these Documentation times, please contact the Event Secretary on to book a time.



Information regarding collecting of RallySafe units will be included in Supplementary Regulations Part Two.

- 6.2 Scrutineering:** Cars will not be cleared to compete at the event until all of the numbers and advertising requirements issued at Documentation are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the car. The Organisers require advertising the spaces **A1**, **A2** and **A3** as per National Sporting Code, Appendix 3, Addenda to Sch R, Schedule R2 to be free for such decals.

Remote Safety Audits are available for this event and is the preferred option for all cars except those entered in NZRC Category 1.

Competitors may arrange for their local Scrutineer to have their car Remote Safety Audited no earlier than 14 days prior to the event. NZRC competitors (excluding Category 1) must only select a local Scrutineer from the list below:

All Remote Safety Audits will be carried out using the MotorSport Online App by your chosen Scrutineer as outlined in National Sporting Code, Appendix Two, Schedule A Part One, Article 3.(4).

For those required to or choosing to Scrutineer at the event, Scrutineering will be held at Riverside Rentals, 271 Dee Street, Avenal, Invercargill from 1:00pm until 3:00pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2026. A map will be supplied in Supplementary Regulations Part Two.

NZRC competitors are reminded that any car that has had 'C' Type seals broken must present their car during event Scrutineering on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2026 for checking and re-sealing; and any car that has a turbo restrictor seal fitted must present their car here for a seal check and Logbook notation.

- 8.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

## 9. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

- 9.1 The Official Notice Board will be located at the Rally Headquarters and all Event Time Controls.

## 10. RALLY SAFE

- 10.1 Vehicle tracking and timing will be done using the RallySafe satellite tracking system. It is a requirement that every competing vehicle be fitted with a RallySafe unit provided by the Organiser.

**Before the event** competitors must purchase and fit a GPS aerial and fitting kit from RallySafe in Australia. This can be ordered online at <http://rallysafe.com.au/>

## 11. RESULTS

- 11.1 Provisional results will be posted at the ILT Ascot Hotel at approximately 6:30pm on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2026.

## 12. STAGE NOTES

- 12.1 The use of Safety Notes is permitted in accordance with National Sporting Code, Appendix 3, Schedule R Part One, Article 8.

Competitors who wish to use Safety Notes and/or participate in Reconnaissance must purchase the Safety Notes directly from the MotorSport New Zealand Authorised Supplier, Rally Notes New Zealand Limited, by emailing [sales@rallynotes.nz](mailto:sales@rallynotes.nz) **no later than 5<sup>th</sup> July 2026**. In the case of a late entry after this date, Stage Notes will not be provided.

There is no obligation on any competitor to purchase the Safety Notes, however, this is a requirement for those competitors who wish to participate in Reconnaissance.

## 13. RECONNAISSANCE

- 13.1 Only competitors who have purchased the approved Safety Notes as per Article 12 are eligible to participate in a single-pass, RSLite-controlled Reconnaissance on Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2026. As per Article 4.3, Reconnaissance fee of **\$65.00** is payable per participating crew.
- 13.2 **Reconnaissance Registration and Briefing:** Before starting Reconnaissance, all crews who have paid the Reconnaissance fee must complete Documentation where each crew will be issued with two sets of numbers – the two large numbers must be displayed on the rear side windows of the Reconnaissance car and must attend the Reconnaissance Briefing at the Documentation venue (ILT Ascot Park Hotel) at 6:30pm on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2026 (held at



the same time and location as the Welcome Evening noted in Article 14.1). All crews must sign in when arriving at this Briefing.

### 13.3 Running of Reconnaissance:

- a. **Timetable:** Access to Special Stage 7 is limited to one hour on Friday morning from 8:00am to 9:00am, so the most efficient Reconnaissance Special Stage sequence is to traverse Special Stage 7 within that window, and then complete Special Stages 1 to 6 in order, however competitors are free to select their own route provided that all other provisions of Article 13 are adhered to.

Marshals may be placed at the start of Special Stages to record entry times. At no time may crews travel in the opposite direction to that described in the Road Book on any Special Stage and any breach of this regulation will be penalised.

- b. **Respect of Reconnaissance Timetable:** No entry into any Special Stage is permitted before 8:00am or after 4:00pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2026.
- c. **RSLite App:** All Reconnaissance crews must have the RSLite App operating on a mobile device from the commencement of their Reconnaissance until the conclusion of their Reconnaissance. The device running the App must be connected to a continuous power source at all times during this time. Information regarding the RSLite App and its functions will be provided in Supplementary Regulations Part Two. Crews are strongly encouraged to install the App on both Crew members' mobile devices to provide redundancy should the primary device malfunction during the Event. The cost of RSLite is included in the Reconnaissance fee.

- d. **Number of passages:** Each crew is limited to one passage of each Special Stage. Crews will only be permitted to enter and leave Special Stages through the start and finish controls. Further checks may also be carried out within Special Stages.
- e. **Speed during Reconnaissance:** The maximum speed limit on all Special Stages is 80kph unless the traffic signs, the Road Book or an Official Bulletin indicates a lower speed limit.
- f. **Headlights:** For safety, headlights must be switched on while driving on all Special Stages.
- g. **Number of persons:** Only the registered competing crew is permitted in each Reconnaissance car unless dispensation is given in writing by the Clerk of the Course.
- h. **Penalties for breaches of the above Reconnaissance regulations:** As per National Sporting Code, Schedule P – Penalties App.1 Sch. P A3R.10(b).

## 14. GENERAL

### 14.1 Promotional Requirements (Welcome Evening and Ceremonial Start):

- 14.1.1 **Welcome Evening** (*and Reconnaissance Briefing*) will be held on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2026, from 6:30pm to 8:00pm, at ILT Ascot Park Hotel. This function provides an excellent opportunity to spend time with and thank our Event and ESCC sponsors, and all crews are encouraged to make an effort to connect with them. Crews should wear team apparel to this function. Media will be in attendance, and finger food will be provided. At this stage, attendance is limited to Drivers and Co-Drivers. Should additional funding become available, confirmation of whether other team members may attend will be advised in Supplementary Regulations Part Two.

- 14.1.2 This year, a Motorshow and Ceremonial Start will be held in the centre of Invercargill on the evening of Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2026. A map of the venue will be included in Supplementary Regulations Part Two.

All crews must participate in the Motorshow and Ceremonial Start, which is a great opportunity to showcase competition vehicles and maximise publicity opportunities for



sponsors. Requests for dispensation from attendance will only be considered in exceptional circumstances and must be submitted in writing to the Event Secretary.

A variety of activities are planned, including signing sessions, rally car displays, and the official Ceremonial Start.

The venue will be open from 4:00pm. All competition cars must be presented at the start venue by 4:30pm and parked as directed by Officials. Competitors should arrive at the scheduled time as advised in Supplementary Regulations Part Two. Cars will depart the Ceremonial Start as directed, with the first car scheduled to leave at 6:00pm.

**14.2 NZRC Power Stage:** The Power Stage for NZRC categories will be Special Stage 4 – Pine Bush. If for any reason this Special Stage is interrupted or cancelled, the Power Stage will then be Special Stage 2 – Wyndham Valley.

**14.3 Early Check In:** Rally Officials may invite crews to check in early to any Time Control without penalty.

**14.4 Servicing:** All Service and Support Vehicles must register with the Organisers before or at the time of Documentation, using the form attached to these Supplementary Regulations Part One.

Services are scheduled in Wyndham after Special Stage 1, then Tokonui after Special Stages 3 and 5.

Service crews are a valued part of the Rally and are often in the public eye throughout the event. Please drive safely and conduct yourselves in a way that reflects positively on the Rally and our sport.

Ground Sheets are to be used under every vehicle during Servicing – please do not leave any mess behind.

There will be food available in the Wyndham and Tokonui Townships – further details will be provided in Supplementary Regulations Part Two.

**14.5 Prizegiving and Social Function:** The Prizegiving and Social Function will be held at the ILT Ascot Park Hotel, Invercargill, commencing following the completion of the Rally. All competitors, service crews, officials, volunteers, sponsors, and supporters are encouraged to attend and help celebrate the event, regardless of whether they hold a Dinner Ticket.

A buffet meal will be available from approximately 7:00pm for all Dinner Ticket holders. The closing date for purchasing Dinner Tickets is Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2026. Please advise the Event Secretary if you have any special dietary requirements by this date also.

Two dinner tickets are included with each rally entry. Additional tickets may be purchased at the time of entry or through the event website at [www.esccrally.co.nz](http://www.esccrally.co.nz) for \$65 per person.

Competitors and guests who do not purchase a buffet ticket before the closing date may still purchase meals from the hotel bar menu, subject to availability.

Prizegiving is expected to commence at approximately 8:00pm.

The venue has a late licence, providing ample opportunity to socialise and celebrate following the formal presentations.

The following major awards will be presented:

- **Barry Robinson Memorial Trophy** – Awarded to the overall winning crew.
- **COMC Barry Robinson Trophy** – Awarded to the highest-placed Class COMC crew, or to the highest-placed COMC driver if no COMC crews finish.
- **Glen Shirlaw Memorial Trophy** – Awarded to the highest-placed OSCC driver.
- In addition, a large number of Overall and Class trophies will be presented.

**14.6 Sponsors:** Our sponsors help make this Rally possible – please support those who support our sport.

**14.7 Behaviour:** Any inconsiderate driving on Special or Touring Stages will result in severe action.

**14.8 Damage:** Competitors are required to report any damage they cause to stock or property to



an official at the next Time Control, or if urgent action is required (and mobile phone coverage is available), it should be reported by calling the Rally Emergency Phone 0800 725 593.

**14.9 Mobile phones:** Mobile phone coverage is improving but should not be considered a reliable means of communications in the Wyndham/Tokonui and Dunsdale areas.

**14.10 Accommodation:** The Invercargill Licensing Trust are a major supporter of the 2026 Barry Robinson Memorial Rally Southland, please support them if you are able – details attached.
