2. Briefings

2.1 Welcome Evening & Compulsory Reconnaissance Briefing:

A Welcome Evening & Compulsory Reconnaissance Briefing will be held on Thursday 16th July 2026, from 6:30pm to 8:00pm, at ILT Ascot Park Hotel.

Reconnaissance Competitors are to sign in on arrival, all other Competitors are welcome to attend.

This function provides an excellent opportunity to spend time with and thank our Event and ESCC sponsors, and all crews are encouraged to make an effort to connect with them. Crews should wear team apparel to this function.

Media will be in attendance, and finger food will be provided.

Drivers, Co-Drivers and Team members welcome

New Competitors: All Drivers and Co-Drivers who have not previously competed in three or more rallies must attend a New Competitors Briefing.

This will take place at the Ascot Park Hotel, 7.30pm Friday 17th July

5 Documentation and Audit Scrutineering

5.1 Documentation

Competitors must present themselves at Documentation for the checking of their Civil Drivers Licence, Competition Licence, Car Club Membership, and Logbook, and issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material.

Documentation for all competitors will be held at the ILT Ascot Park Hotel, corner of Tay Street and Racecourse Road, Invercargill from 3:30pm until 5:30pm on Thursday 16th July 2026.

A second period of Documentation available to those not doing Reconnaissance will be held at the ILT Ascot Park Hotel, corner of Tay Street and Racecourse Road, Invercargill from 12:30pm to 1:30pm on Friday 17th July 2026.

Rallysafe Units will be available to collect at these times

If you are unable to attend these Documentation times, please contact the Event Secretary on 027 419 0642 to book a time.

You will be advised if you have to have your car audited.

We would like a cellphone number your service crew may be contacted on during the rally please, if you haven't put this on your Service Crew Registration Form, please bring this with you to documentation.

5.2 Scrutineering

For those required to or are choosing to Scrutineer at the event, Scrutineering will be held at Riverside Rentals, 271 Dee Street, Avenal, Invercargill from 1:00pm until 3:00pm on Friday 17th July 2026. Post event Scrutineering is at the same venue.

NZRC competitors are reminded that any car that has had 'C' Type seals broken must present their car during event Scrutineering on Friday 17th July 2026 for checking and re-sealing; and any car that has a turbo restrictor seal fitted must present their car here for a seal check and Logbook notation.

6 Service

A Service Crew Form is attached, please make sure you get that sorted and returned or bring with you to Doco, please don't leave it to your holding everybody else up on Friday Night.

Service Parks after Stages 1, 3 & 5

Servicing will be done in the Wyndham and Tokonui townships, as shown on the Maps attached.

There is tons of room, remember peoples gate ways please and don't leave a mess behind for us to have to deal with, also we have added extra Toilets in both townships, please don't let the Sport we love down.

There will be a Refuel Zone between SS6 and SS7 in Wyndham please observe the MotorSport NZ best practice for safety when refueling (<https://motorsport.org.nz/wp-content/uploads/Code-of-Practice-Fuel-21122023.pdf>)



7. Towing

The Recovery 4WD vehicles will be following Sweeper Car and will tow competitor's vehicles as required to assist them back onto the road only. There will be **NO** charge for this service.

Major vehicle recovery will be done at the completion of the rally!

8. Rejoining

After handing in a Temporary Withdrawal form, you may rejoin with a Rejoining Form at the start of any of the stages, Assistant Clerk of the Course and / or the Chief Scrutineer or an assistant will be available at the start of the stages.

9 Prizegiving and Social Function

The Prizegiving and Social Function will be held at the ILT Ascot Park Hotel, Invercargill, commencing following the completion of the Rally. All competitors, service crews, officials, volunteers, sponsors, and supporters are encouraged to attend and help celebrate the event, regardless of whether they hold a Dinner Ticket.

A buffet meal will be available from approximately 7:00pm for all Dinner Ticket holders.

Two dinner tickets are included with each rally entry.

Competitors and guests who do not purchase a buffet ticket before the closing date may still purchase meals from the hotel bar menu, subject to availability.

Prizegiving is expected to commence at approximately 8:00pm.

The venue has a late licence, 1am, providing ample opportunity to socialise and celebrate following the formal presentations.

10 General

This year, a Motorshow and Ceremonial Start will be held in the centre of Invercargill on the evening of Friday 17th July 2026. A map of the venue and your arrival Time will be included in your drivers pack collected at Documentation

All crews must participate in the Motorshow and Ceremonial Start, which is a great opportunity to showcase competition vehicles and maximise publicity opportunities for sponsors. Requests for dispensation from attendance will only be considered in exceptional circumstances and must be submitted in writing to the Event Secretary.

A variety of activities are planned, including signing sessions, rally car displays, and the official Ceremonial Start.

The venue will be open from 4:00pm, please arrive at the time you have been given. All competition cars must be presented at the start venue by 4:30pm and parked as directed by Officials. Cars will depart the Ceremonial Start as directed, with the first cars scheduled to leave at 6:00pm.

10.1 Rallysafe

10.1.3 Rallysafe return of Units; Units are to be handed in with any Permanent Withdrawal from the Rally or at the finish at Ascot Park Hotel.

10.2 Virtual Chicanes (VC)

The following Virtual Chicane signs are used in this event. The yellow sign provides a 100m warning. You must then slow to the speed indicated on the red sign between that sign and the end of control sign. Once you slow to the target speed your Rallysafe unit screen will go green with the words 'GO', you must not accelerate again until you receive this message from your Rallysafe unit.



The VC zone will have a target speed of 30 kph, with the exception of one zone in SS7 that has a target speed of 70kph, this is monitored by Rallysafe. Your Rallysafe unit will also advise you of the VC zone.

Penalties – Failing to reduce your speed to the VC target speed will incur a penalty of 2 seconds added to your stage time for every 1 kph over the target speed for the VC. Penalties will be applied at the Judge of Fact – Speed's discretion.

10.3 SS2 – Neutralisation Zone (NZ)

The following neutralisation zone signs will be used on this event. The yellow sign provides a 100m warning. A competitor must reduce their speed to 70km/h before the second sign. A competitor may accelerate again once the Restricted Speed Zone ends after the third sign.



The NZ zone will have a max speed of 70kph and a minimum speed of 30kph, this is monitored by Rallysafe. Your Rallysafe unit will also advise you of the NZ zone.

Penalties - Exceeding 70 kph or travelling less than 30 kph within the zone will incur a 20 second time penalty added to the competitors stage time.

Stopping within the zone will incur a 5 minute time penalty added to the competitors stage time, or the actual time stopped, whichever is the greater.

Timing will be neutralised from the 100m warning sign to the zone ends sign.

Penalties will be applied at the Judge of Fact – Speed's discretion.

10.4 Appendix 3 – Schedule R Article 3, (2)

At the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course, it is permissible to allow a change of co-driver during this event.

Points that this may occur will be the same as the rejoining stage numbers as long as all the conditions of rule (2) are met.

10.5 Helmets are not to be worn on touring stages

Please, it is a very bad look for our sport.

10.6 Please note that cell phones shouldn't be considered a reliable means of communication in the Wyndham & Tokonui areas. Reception may be available in parts of Stages, as well as the Wyndham & Tokonui townships.

10.7 The Wyndham and Tokonui Service Areas food outlets, the Three Rivers Hotel have put together a special Rally Menu attached, a great crew there, please support them. In Wyndham there is also a Four Square and a Good Dairy with hot food too.

10.8 In the Tokonui Service Area / township there is Hot Food available both at the Tokonui Traven Bistro (Dine in or Take away) and the Tokonui Store where our CRO's will be based, Map attached.

10.9 We have put extra Toilets in the Wyndham Service area in addition to the Balaclava Street ones, plus at every Special Stage Start and major Spectator areas, they are there to be used.
